

Bureau of International Recycling to host Oslo conference on aluminum recycling

PHILADELPHIA — The Bureau of International Recycling (BIR), Brussels, will host a one-day symposium focused on aluminum recycling May 26 in Oslo, Norway.

The symposium will be held in conjunction with the BIR's spring convention, which is scheduled for May 26-28 in Oslo.

The aluminum symposium will include four sessions, each dedicated to a different aspect of aluminum production and recycling. More than 20 speakers will provide reports on the

aluminum industry and recycling markets. International trade issues and challenges also will be discussed, as well as the importance of sustainability as a guarantee for future raw material supply.

Keynote speakers and panelists for the symposium will be announced in the coming weeks, the trade group said. Several North American and European metals producers and scrap companies already had enrolled in the event.
