Bird, also chief operating officer of Chiho Environmental Group in Hong Kong, takes over from Ranjit Baxi, who served as president for the past four years. Bird's appointment was approved by the General Assembly for a first two-year mandate, which can only be extended once. He had been BIR Treasurer and a member of the organization's executive committee for three years, as well as interim president of the ferrous division and chairman of the internal audit committee. He also served as president of the European Ferrous Recovery and Recycling Federation.

International Stainless Steel Forum — Bernardo Velázquez, chief executive officer of Spain-based stainless steel producer Acerinox, has been elected chairman of the International Stainless Steel Forum (ISSF) for a two-year period until 2021, Acerinox said on Thursday May 23.
