BIR is proud to announce that it has secured the participation of an internationally acclaimed conference speaker for its General Assembly on Tuesday, 25th May 2004 at 16.00 hrs.

Dr Albert Rohan, former Secretary General of the Austrian Ministry of Foreign Affairs and former Ambassador to Argentina, Uruguay and Paraguay, will give a highly topical insight in the 'Hot irons of international politics'. Conflicts in the Middle East, the predominance of China and the role of Russia are part of the analytical overview that Dr Rohan intends to provide.
